

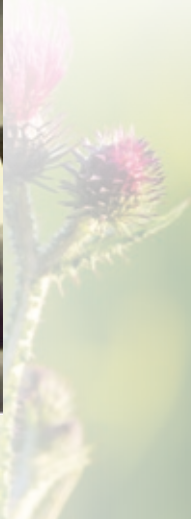

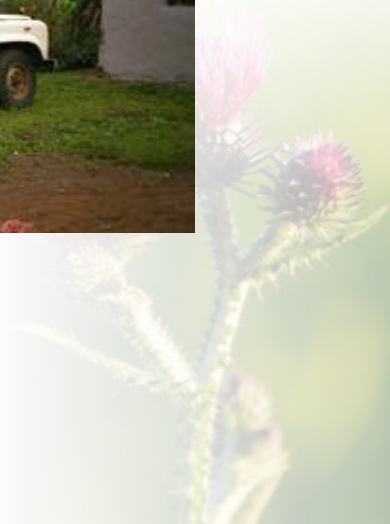

(Peter Cooke learnt to play the ndere flute with Blasio Busulwa and taught music at Kyambogo, alongside Busulwa. Busulwa died at a young age, but Peter continued to care for Busulwa's family, paying all the primary and secondary school fees for his son).
